

Message from Fr. Sebastian MISSION SUNDAY

While reaffirming the role of the church in radiating the Good News of Jesus Christ to the world, Mission Sunday calls us to express our solidarity with all the missionaries world over. They are actively immersed in sharing the mission through their physical presence and witnessing even amidst the most hostile and anti-missionary circumstances. It was in 1926 that Pope Pius XI decided to have a day set apart in the month of October as Mission Sunday. This year's celebration is amidst terrorism, violence and war in the Holy Land where the world witnessed the message and the messenger of Good News, our Lord Jesus Christ. God the Father has sent His own son to bring the good news to us. The sacrificial offering, the collection made on this day, as Pope Francis specifies, is for "the missionary work carried out in my name by the Pontifical Mission Societies, in order to meet the spiritual and material needs of peoples and Churches throughout the world, for the salvation of all." And the theme we celebrate this year is: "Whom shall I send?" The theme reflected on by Pope Francis is based on the encounter of the disciples with Jesus on the way to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35): Hearts on fire, feet on the move! Fr. Sebastian T. La celebración de este año se produce en medio del terrorismo, la violencia y la guerra en Tierra Santa, donde el mundo fue testigo del mensaje y del mensajero de la Buena Nueva, nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Dios Padre ha enviado a Su propio hijo para traernos las buenas nuevas. La ofrenda sacrificial, la colecta que se hace en este día, como especifica el Papa Francisco, es para "la obra misionera que realizan en mi nombre las Obras Misionales Pontificias, para satisfacer las necesidades espirituales y materiales de los pueblos y de las Iglesias en todo el mundo, para la salvación de todos". Y el tema que celebramos este año es: "¿A quién enviaré?" El tema reflexionado por el Papa Francisco se basa en el encuentro de los discípulos con Jesús en el camino a Emaús (Lc 24,13-35): ¡Corazones en llamas, pies en movimiento!

In today's Gospel reading, some men asked Jesus if it was right to pay tax. What did Jesus ask them to show Him? Connect the dots to find out! Should we Obey the Government?



The Pharisees in today's Gospel reading were trying to trick Jesus and make Him say something wrong. They asked Him whether they should pay taxes to the pagan emperor. If He said no then He would be speaking against the emperor, but if He said yes then it would seem like He was saying that it

was good for the Jews to be ruled by the pagan Romans.

But Jesus knew what the Pharisees were trying to do. He told them to show Him a coin, and asked them whose picture was on it. They said it was Caesar's (the Roman emperor's,) so Jesus told them, "Then repay to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's." He was telling them that they should obey the rulers of the land, but also that they should obey God.

We have two kinds of laws: God's laws and the laws of our governments. Both are for our own good, but God's laws are more important. We should obey the government's laws as long as they agree with God's laws, but we must always obey God's laws. Can you think of some laws that the government makes that are for our good?




