St. Chavara Kuriakose Elias January 3rd / 3 de Enero

Saint Chavara Kuriakose Elias, is a pioneering figure in the Catholic Church and a renowned social reformer in the 19th century in India. He was born on February 10, 1805, in Kerala, India, into a devout Christian family. Chavara Kuriakose Elias received his early education in a local school and later had his priestly formation at the Seminary in Pallippuram. Recognizing his intellectual and spiritual gifts, he was ordained as a priest on November 29, 1829.

Saint Chavara, along with Fr. Thomas Palackal, Fr. Thomas Porukara, and Bro. Jacob Kaniyanthara played a crucial role in founding the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI) - a religious congregation- in 1831 at Mannanam, India. He made his religious profession on December 08, 1855. This religious order aimed to foster spiritual renewal, education, and social welfare, especially among the marginalized.

Saint Chavara was a strong advocate for education, and he established schools across Kerala to provide quality education for all, irrespective of caste or creed. His efforts in the field of education significantly contributed to the empowerment of the marginalized and the promotion of gender equality in society.

In addition to his educational initiatives, Saint Chavara served as the Vicar General for the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church and worked towards the renewal of the Church, emphasizing a balance between spiritual growth and social responsibility.

Saint Chavara's spirituality was deeply rooted in devotion to the Holy Eucharist and the Virgin Mary. He wrote extensively on spirituality, leaving behind a legacy of religious texts and poems that continue to inspire the faithful. Saint Chavara Kuriakose Elias was called for his eternal reward on January 03, 1871, and canonized by Pope Francis on November 23, 2014. His canonization recognizes not only his individual sanctity but also the profound impact of the CMI congregation in promoting education, social justice, and spirituality.

Saint Chavara Kuriakose Elias remains an iconic figure, revered for his multifaceted contributions to education, social reform, and the spiritual life of the Christian community in India and beyond. His life serves as an enduring testament to the transformative power of faith, education, and social justice.

San Chavara Kuriakose Elias, es una figura pionera de la Iglesia católica y un reconocido reformador social del siglo XIX en la India. Nació el 10 de febrero de 1805 en Kerala, India, en una familia cristiana devota. Chavara Kuriakose Elias recibió su educación inicial en una escuela local y luego tuvo su formación sacerdotal en el Seminario de Pallippuram. Reconociendo sus dotes intelectuales y espirituales, fue ordenado sacerdote el 29 de noviembre de 1829.

Santa Chavara, junto con el P. Tomás Palackal, el P. Thomas Porukara y el hermano. Jacob Kaniyanthara jugó un papel crucial en la fundación de los Carmelitas de María Inmaculada (CMI), una congregación religiosa, en 1831 en Mannanam, India. Hizo su profesión religiosa el 8 de diciembre de 1855. Esta orden religiosa tenía como objetivo fomentar la renovación espiritual, la educación y el bienestar social, especialmente entre los marginados.

Saint Chavara fue un firme defensor de la educación y estableció escuelas en todo Kerala para brindar educación de calidad para todos, independientemente de su casta o credo. Sus esfuerzos en el campo de la educación contribuyeron significativamente al empoderamiento de los marginados y la promoción de la igualdad de género en la sociedad.

Además de sus iniciativas educativas, San Chavara se desempeñó como Vicario General de la Iglesia Católica Siro-Malabar y trabajó por la renovación de la Iglesia, enfatizando el equilibrio entre el crecimiento espiritual y la responsabilidad social.

La espiritualidad de Santa Chávara estaba profundamente arraigada en la devoción a la Sagrada Eucaristía y a la Virgen María. Escribió extensamente sobre espiritualidad, dejando un legado de textos y poemas religiosos que continúan inspirando a los fieles. San Chavara Kuriakose Elias fue llamado a su recompensa eterna el 3 de enero de 1871 y canonizado por el Papa Francisco el 23 de noviembre de 2014. Su canonización reconoce no sólo su santidad individual sino también el profundo impacto de la congregación CMI en la promoción de la educación y la justicia social, y espiritualidad.

San Chavara Kuriakose Elias sigue siendo una figura icónica, venerada por sus contribuciones multifacéticas a la educación, la reforma social y la vida espiritual de la comunidad cristiana en la India y más allá. Su vida es un testimonio duradero del poder transformador de la fe, la educación y la justicia social.





We can imitate the Holy Family by loving our parents and siblings and putting others before ourselves. What can you do today to make your family happier and holier?
