





Message from Fr. Sinto - The Call to Discipleship

“The kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel.” (Mk 1. 15) These words Jesus echo with divine urgency, signaling a new era and a radical shift. The Kingdom of God is not a distant concept but a present reality, inviting a response of repentance and belief. In the midst of this proclamation, Jesus encountered Simon and Andrew, casting their nets by the sea. His call was simple yet profound: “Follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men.” They left their nets and followed Him. The sons of Zebedee also did the same.

The willingness of these fishermen to leave their occupations and families reveals the radical nature of Jesus’ call. It transcends the ordinary and beckons them to step into the extraordinary. The act of leaving signifies a detachment from the familiar and an embrace of a new identity and purpose. The call to discipleship is not merely an invitation to follow a charismatic leader but a call to participate in the redemptive mission of God. The disciples are invited to become “fishers of men,” actively engaged in the work of drawing people into the Kingdom.

This incident underscores the transformative nature of discipleship. The act of following Jesus is not passive but a journey of becoming. The disciples are called to be shaped and molded by the teachings, actions, and very presence of the Master. In leaving behind their nets, they embrace a new vocation that aligns with the greater narrative of God’s redemptive plan.

In a world marked by competing voices and distractions, Jesus’ call remains an anchor, inviting us to reorient our lives toward the Kingdom of God. The disciples’ response challenges us to examine our readiness to follow Jesus in the midst of life’s demands.

The call to discipleship, with its radical demands and transformative promises, echoes through the corridors of time, inviting each of us to respond to Jesus’ invitation: “Come after me.” May we, like the fishermen of Galilee, heed the call, leave behind the familiar, and embark on a journey of discipleship that leads us into the heart of God’s Kingdom.

Un Mensaje del Padre Sinto - El llamado al discipulado

“El reino de Dios está cerca; arrepiéntanse y crean en el evangelio”. (Mc 1, 15) Estas palabras de Jesús resuenan con urgencia divina, señalando una nueva era y un cambio radical. El Reino de Dios no es un concepto lejano sino una realidad presente, que invita a una respuesta de arrepentimiento y fe. En medio de esta proclamación, Jesús se encontró con Simón y Andrés, que echaban sus redes junto al mar. Su llamado fue simple pero profundo: “Seguidme y os haré pescadores de hombres”. Dejaron sus redes y lo siguieron. Los hijos de Zebedeo también hicieron lo mismo.

La voluntad de estos pescadores de dejar sus ocupaciones y familias revela la naturaleza radical del llamado de Jesús. Trasciende lo ordinario y los invita a dar un paso hacia lo extraordinario. El acto de partir significa un desapego de lo familiar y la aceptación de una nueva identidad y propósito. El llamado al discipulado no es simplemente una invitación a seguir a un líder carismático sino un llamado a participar en la misión redentora de Dios. Se invita a los discípulos a convertirse en “pescadores de hombres”, participando activamente en la obra de atraer personas al Reino.

Este incidente subraya la naturaleza transformadora del discipulado. El acto de seguir a Jesús no es pasivo sino un camino de devenir. Los discípulos están llamados a ser formados y moldeados por las enseñanzas, las acciones y la presencia misma del Maestro. Al dejar atrás sus redes, abrazan una nueva vocación que se alinea con la narrativa más amplia del plan redentor de Dios.

En un mundo marcado por voces contrapuestas y distracciones, el llamado de Jesús sigue siendo un ancla que nos invita a reorientar nuestras vidas hacia el Reino de Dios. La respuesta de los discípulos nos desafía a examinar nuestra disposición a seguir a Jesús en medio de las exigencias de la vida.

El llamado al discipulado, con sus demandas radicales y promesas transformadoras, resuena a través de los pasillos del tiempo, invitándonos a cada uno de nosotros a responder a la invitación de Jesús: “Venid en pos de mí”. Que nosotros, como los pescadores de Galilea, prestemos atención al llamado, dejemos atrás lo familiar y embarquemos en un viaje de discipulado que nos lleve al corazón del Reino de Dios.
