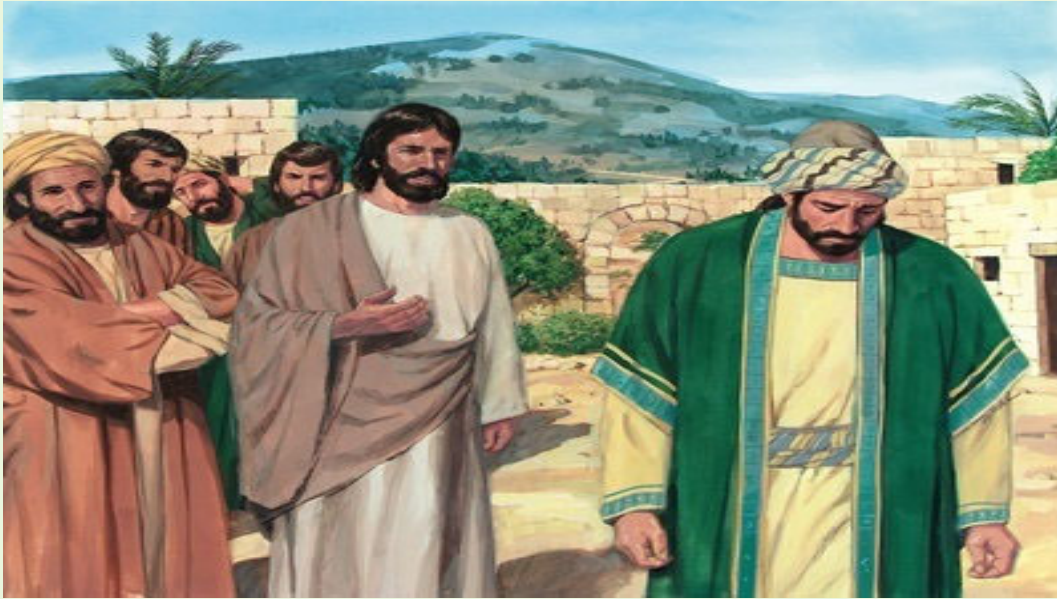

MESSAGE FROM FR. SINTO

You are Lacking in One Thing!

Jesus' interaction with a 'Rich Young Man' (Mk 10:17-27) addresses the relationship between wealth, discipleship, and the Kingdom of God.

Jesus' instruction to the young man- "Go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me"- shifts the focus from mere obedience to the law toward a radical form of discipleship. This command is not merely about charity or poverty; it represents the heart of Christian discipleship: a total renunciation of anything that hinders a wholehearted commitment to God. Jesus identifies the man's wealth as the obstacle preventing him from fully embracing the Kingdom.

Peter, in response to Jesus' teaching, points out that the disciples have left everything to follow Him. Jesus acknowledges their sacrifice and promises that those who leave behind their possessions, families, and social status for the sake of the Kingdom will receive a hundredfold in this life and eternal life in the age to come. This promise affirms the value of the sacrificial path of discipleship. Discipleship involves both reward and challenge, blessing and sacrifice.

Ultimately, the 'Rich Young Man' is a wakening call for us to reflect on the radical nature of discipleship. Wealth and material security, while not inherently evil, can obscure the path to the Kingdom by fostering self-reliance rather than reliance on divine grace. The invitation to 'come, follow me' remains as demanding today as it was for the rich young man, calling us to reorient our lives toward God, trusting that in giving up our attachments, we gain everything in Christ. **Fr. UN MENSAJE DEL PADRE SINTO

¡Te falta una cosa!

La interacción de Jesús con un "joven rico" (Mc 10:17-27) aborda la relación entre la riqueza, el discipulado y el Reino de Dios.

La instrucción de Jesús al joven: "Ve, vende todo lo que tienes y dalo a los pobres, y tendrás un tesoro en el cielo; luego ven y sígueme" cambia el enfoque de la mera obediencia a la ley hacia una forma radical de discipulado. Este mandato no se refiere meramente a la caridad o la pobreza; representa el corazón del discipulado cristiano: una renuncia total a todo lo que impida un compromiso sincero con Dios. Jesús identifica la riqueza del hombre como el obstáculo que le impide abrazar plenamente el Reino.

Pedro, en respuesta a la enseñanza de Jesús, señala que los discípulos han dejado todo para seguirlo. Jesús reconoce su sacrificio y promete que quienes dejen atrás sus posesiones, familias y estatus social por el bien del Reino recibirán el ciento por uno en esta vida y la vida eterna en la era venidera. Esta promesa afirma el valor del camino sacrificial del discipulado. El discipulado implica tanto recompensa como desafío, bendición y sacrificio.

En última instancia, el "joven rico" es un llamado de atención para que reflexionemos sobre la naturaleza radical del discipulado. La riqueza y la seguridad material, aunque no son inherentemente malas, pueden oscurecer el camino hacia el Reino al fomentar la autosuficiencia en lugar de la confianza en la gracia divina. La invitación a "ven y sígueme" sigue siendo tan exigente hoy como lo fue para el joven rico, y nos llama a reorientar nuestras vidas hacia Dios, confiando en que al renunciar a nuestros apegos, ganamos todo en Cristo. **P.
