### **MESSAGE FROM FR. SEBASTIAN**

#### **Cost of Discipleship**

*The Pilgrim's Progress* (1678) by John Bunyan was a landmark in Christian allegorical fiction ever written in English. Although it refers to Catholicism in a shady manner and was in the forbidden category for reading, the insights of this writing cannot be ignored. So also, another book that was published in 1937 by a Lutheran pastor, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, *The Cost of Discipleship* stands out in interpreting the price we have to pay to be a disciple of Jesus.

When we reflect this week on Mark 10:35-45, we come across the journey of the disciples of Jesus and their expectations getting transformed over time in the company of Jesus. 'Come, follow me' was an easy invitation and a general one. Getting to the core of that invitation changes the very expectation of the disciples and their perception on discipleship. The moment James and John approached Jesus with the request, in other narratives their mother goes to Jesus with the recommendation; their worldly ambition becomes quite clear. They wanted a key role, an influential one, in the kingdom to be established by Jesus. Jesus in turn uses this moment as a teaching moment. "Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." It becomes a great moment of progressively growing into the meaning of Christian baptism. It is a journey of service ultimately giving meaning to the life of a Christian. **Fr. Sebastian T. Augustine CMI, Pastor**

### **UN MENSAJE DEL PADRE SEBASTIAN**

El Progreso del Peregrino (1678) de John Bunyan fue un hito en la ficción alegórica cristiana jamás escrita en inglés. Aunque se refiere al catolicismo de una manera sospechosa y estaba en la categoría de lectura prohibida, las ideas de este escrito no pueden ignorarse. Así también, otro libro que fue publicado en 1937 por un pastor luterano, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, El costo del discipulado se destaca en la interpretación del precio que tenemos que pagar para ser un discípulo de Jesús.

Cuando reflexionamos esta semana sobre Marcos 10:35-45, nos encontramos con el viaje de los discípulos de Jesús y sus expectativas transformándose con el tiempo en compañía de Jesús. "Ven, sígueme" fue una invitación fácil y general. Llegar al núcleo de esa invitación cambia la expectativa misma de los discípulos y su percepción sobre el discipulado. El momento en que Santiago y Juan se acercaron a Jesús con la solicitud, en otras narraciones su madre va a Jesús con la recomendación; su ambición mundana se vuelve bastante clara. Ellos querían un papel clave, influyente, en el reino que Jesús iba a establecer. Jesús, a su vez, utiliza este momento como una enseñanza: "El Hijo del hombre no vino para ser servido, sino para servir y dar su vida en rescate por muchos". Se convierte en un gran momento de crecimiento progresivo en el significado del bautismo cristiano. Es un camino de servicio que, en última instancia, da sentido a la vida del cristiano. **P. 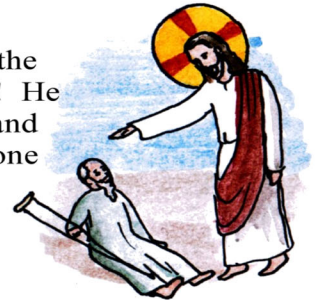
In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells us that the people who are really great are those who serve. Here are some really great people:

## Saint John Paul II October 22

KAROL WOJTYLA WAS BORN IN POLAND IN 1920. BY THE TIME HE WAS 21, HIS PARENTS AND BROTHER HAD ALL DIED. DURING WORLD WAR II HE WENT TO A SECRET SEMINARY.

HE WAS ORDAINED AND SENT TO ROME TO STUDY FURTHER, AND THEN HE BECAME A PROFESSOR.

FR. WOJTYLA LOVED TEACHING THE YOUNG PEOPLE. SOON HE WAS ORDAINED A BISHOP.

HE WAS AT THE SECOND VATICAN COUNCIL, AND A FEW YEARS LATER WAS MADE A CARDINAL.

IN 1978 HE BECAME POPE JOHN PAUL II. HE WENT TO MANY COUNTRIES TO EVANGELIZE AND MAKE PEACE.

IN 1981 THE POPE WAS SHOT BY AN ASSASSIN BUT HE SURVIVED. MANY PEOPLE WERE PRAYING TO OUR LADY.

POPE JOHN PAUL WORKED FOR MANY YEARS TRYING TO BRING PEACE AND HOPE TO THE WORLD. EVEN WHEN HE WAS OLD AND SUFFERED FROM PARKINSON'S DISEASE. HE DIED ON APRIL 2, 2005

SAINT JOHN PAUL GREW UP IN A TIME AND PLACE WHERE THERE WAS WAR ALL AROUND HIM. HE PRAYED AND WORKED TO BRING PEACE TO MANY NATIONS. WE SHOULD TRY TO BE PEACEFUL IN OUR FAMILIES AND SCHOOLS, AND PRAY FOR PEACE IN COUNTRIES WHERE PEOPLE ARE AT WAR.

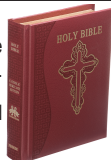
