MESSAGE FROM FR. SEBASTIAN

Living the Commandments

‘Happy, blissful, and fortunate’ were the original meaning of the old English word ‘silly,’ deriving from ‘sælig.’ It also gained the meaning ‘blessed’ and ‘pious’ eventually and also ‘innocent.’ It is the story of how we degenerate the meaning of a word over a time to mean ‘insignificant’ or ‘pitiable.’ However, Jesus is affirming the scribe who approached him to know the way to eternal life for reassurance (Mk 12:28-34). In other words, he would like to be a saint and he wanted to be one without taking much trouble. He knows all the commandments and the true spirit of the commandments. He reaffirms and agrees with the words of Jesus that the sum of all the commandments is to love God and the neighbor. However, it is a story left incomplete as to whether this scribe was ready to take up the challenge of a radical discipleship for the sake of the kingdom of God. The saints chose radical discipleship deep enough to radiate the world with the light received from Jesus Christ.

“Feliz, dichoso y afortunado” era el significado original de la antigua palabra inglesa “tonto”, derivada de “sælig”. Es la historia de cómo con el tiempo degeneramos el significado de una palabra hasta significar “insignificante” o “miserable”. Sin embargo, Jesús está afirmando al escriba que se acercó a él para conocer el camino a la vida eterna en busca de seguridad (Mc 12:28-34). En otras palabras, le gustaría ser santo y quería serlo sin mucho esfuerzo. Conoce todos los mandamientos y el verdadero espíritu de los mandamientos. Reafirma y está de acuerdo con las palabras de Jesús de que la suma de todos los mandamientos es amar a Dios y al prójimo. Sin embargo, es una historia que queda incompleta en cuanto a si este escriba estaba listo para aceptar el desafío de un discipulado radical por el bien del reino de Dios. Los santos eligieron un discipulado radical lo suficientemente profundo como para irradiar al mundo con la luz recibida de Jesucristo.
