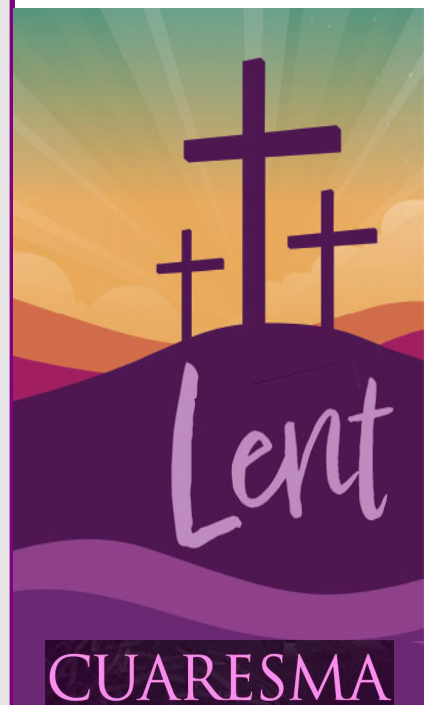

## MESSAGE FROM FR. BENNY

### Pleasure, Pride & Power: The Temptations of Jesus!

After His baptism in the Jordan, after the heavens opened and the Father declared, “This is my beloved Son,” the Spirit leads Jesus into the wilderness. Not into comfort. Not into applause. But into temptation. This already teaches us something profound: temptation is not a sign that God has abandoned us. Sometimes, it is precisely in the desert that God prepares us for mission.

#### **1. The First Temptation: Stones into Bread**

After forty days of fasting, Jesus is hungry. The tempter says, “If you are the Son of God, command these stones to become bread.” It sounds reasonable. What is wrong with bread? What is wrong with solving hunger? But the temptation is deeper. It is this: *Use your power for yourself. Put your physical needs above obedience to the Father.* Jesus replies, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.”

How often are we tempted to reduce our lives to “bread alone”? To live only for money, food, comfort, security, pleasure? These things are not evil in themselves. But when they become first, God becomes secondary. Jesus teaches us that our deepest hunger is not for bread, but for God.

#### **2. The Second Temptation: Testing God**

The devil takes Jesus to the pinnacle of the Temple and says, “Throw yourself down... for the angels will catch you.” This temptation is about pride and presumption. It is about forcing God’s hand. “Prove that you are the Son of God. Make a spectacle. Impress everyone.” How subtle this temptation is in our lives! We may not jump from buildings, but we sometimes demand signs. “Lord, if You really love me, fix this immediately.” “If You are there, prove it.”

Jesus answers, “You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.” Faith is not about manipulating God. It is about trusting Him — even when there is no dramatic miracle, no visible sign, no immediate solution.

#### **3. The Third Temptation: Power and Glory**

Finally, the devil shows Jesus all the kingdoms of the world and says, “All these I will give you, if you fall down and worship me.” Here is the ultimate temptation: power without the cross. Glory without sacrifice. A crown without Calvary. Jesus came to save the world. Satan offers Him a shortcut. No suffering. No rejection. Just immediate success.

But Jesus says, “You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him alone shall you serve.”

Brothers and sisters, this temptation is alive in every generation. We are tempted to compromise our values for success. To remain silent about truth for approval. To gain influence at the cost of integrity. But there are no shortcuts to holiness. There is no resurrection without the cross.

The temptations of Jesus are not random. They touch the three great human weaknesses: **Pleasure** (bread), **Pride** (testing God) and **Power** (worldly glory)

When tempted by pleasure let us say: “**God is enough.**” When tempted by pride let us say: “**I trust You, Lord.**” When tempted by power let us say: “**You alone I worship.**”

## UN MENSAJE DEL PADRE BENNY

### Placer, orgullo y poder: ¡Las tentaciones de Jesús!

Tras su bautismo en el Jordán, tras la apertura de los cielos y la declaración del Padre: «Este es mi Hijo amado», el Espíritu conduce a Jesús al desierto. No a la comodidad. No a los aplausos. Sino a la tentación. Esto ya nos enseña algo profundo: la tentación no es señal de que Dios nos ha abandonado. A veces, es precisamente en el desierto donde Dios nos prepara para la misión.

#### **1. La primera tentación: Piedras convertidas en pan**

Tras cuarenta días de ayuno, Jesús siente hambre. El tentador le dice: «Si eres Hijo de Dios, ordena que estas piedras se conviertan en pan». Suena razonable. ¿Qué tiene de malo el pan? ¿Qué tiene de malo solucionar el problema del hambre? Pero la tentación es más profunda. Es esta: *Usa tu poder para ti mismo. Antepone tus necesidades físicas a la obediencia al Padre.* Jesús responde: «No solo de pan vivirá el hombre, sino de toda palabra que sale de la boca de Dios».

¿Con cuánta frecuencia nos sentimos tentados a reducir nuestras vidas a "solo pan"? ¿Vivir solo para el dinero, la comida, la comodidad, la seguridad, el placer? Estas cosas no son malas en sí mismas. Pero cuando se vuelven primordiales, Dios pasa a segundo plano. Jesús nos enseña que nuestra hambre más profunda no es de pan, sino de Dios.

#### **2. La segunda tentación: poner a prueba a Dios**

El diablo lleva a Jesús a la cima del Templo y le dice: «Tírate abajo... porque los ángeles te atraparán». Esta tentación se trata de orgullo y presunción. Se trata de forzar la mano de Dios. «Demuestra que eres el Hijo de Dios. Da un espectáculo. Impresiona a todos».

¿Qué sutil es esta tentación en nuestras vidas! Puede que no saltemos de los edificios, pero a veces exigimos señales. «Señor, si de verdad me amas, arréglo de inmediato». «Si estás ahí, demuéstremelo».

Jesús responde: «No tentarás al Señor tu Dios». La fe no consiste en manipular a Dios. Se trata de confiar en él, incluso cuando no hay un milagro espectacular, ninguna señal visible ni una solución inmediata.

#### **3. La tercera tentación: poder y gloria**

Finalmente, el diablo le muestra a Jesús todos los reinos del mundo y le dice: «Todo esto te daré si te postras y me adoras». Aquí está la tentación máxima: poder sin la cruz. Gloria sin sacrificio. Una corona sin el Calvario. Jesús vino a salvar al mundo. Satanás le ofrece un atajo. Sin sufrimiento. Sin rechazo. Solo éxito inmediato.

Pero Jesús dice: «Al Señor tu Dios adorarás, y sólo a él servirás».

Hermanos y hermanas, esta tentación está presente en cada generación. Nos sentimos tentados a comprometer nuestros valores por el éxito. A callar la verdad para obtener aprobación. A ganar influencia a costa de la integridad. Pero no hay atajos hacia la santidad. No hay resurrección sin la cruz.

Las tentaciones de Jesús no son casuales. Afectan las tres grandes debilidades humanas: **el placer** (el pan), **el orgullo** (probar a Dios) y **el poder** (la gloria mundana).

Cuando nos tienta el placer, digamos: «**Dios me basta**». Cuando nos tienta el orgullo, digamos: «**Confío en Ti, Señor**». Cuando nos tienta el poder, digamos: «**Solo a Ti adoro**».

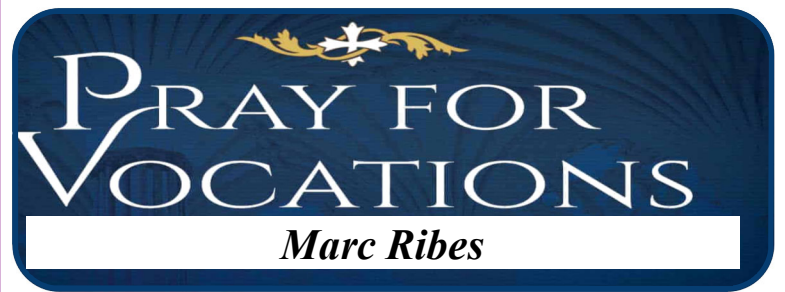

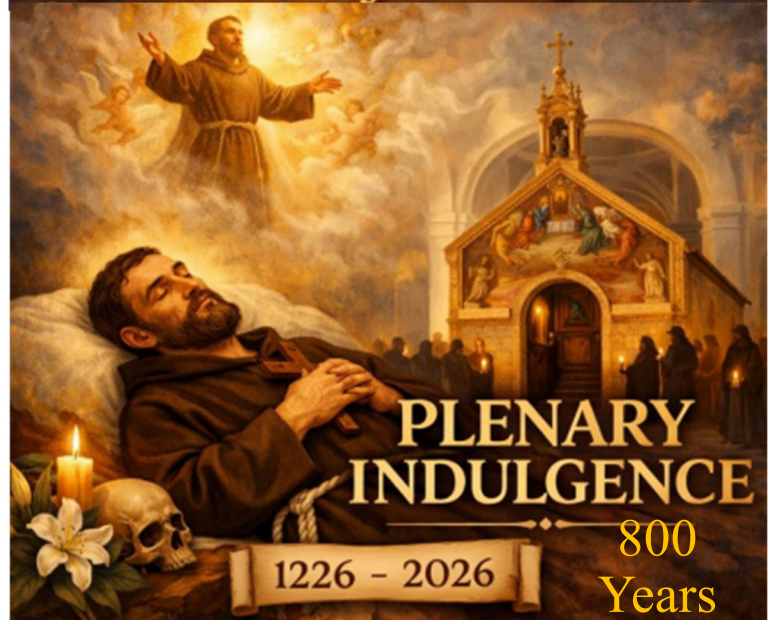

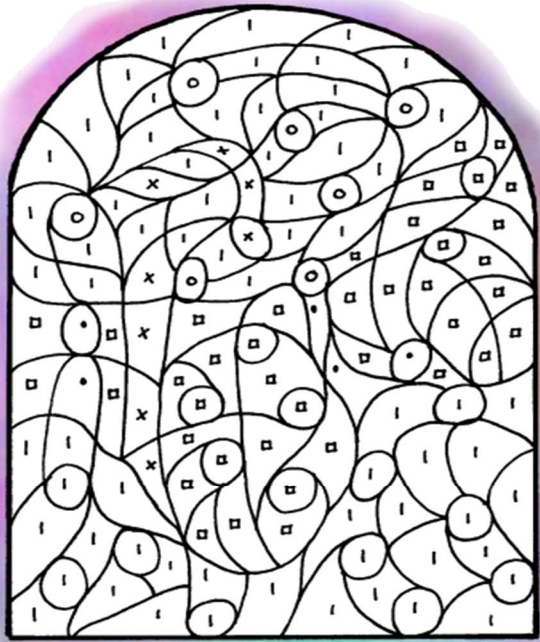
### How to obtain a plenary Indulgence during the Franciscan Jubilee Year January 10 2026 - January 10 2027

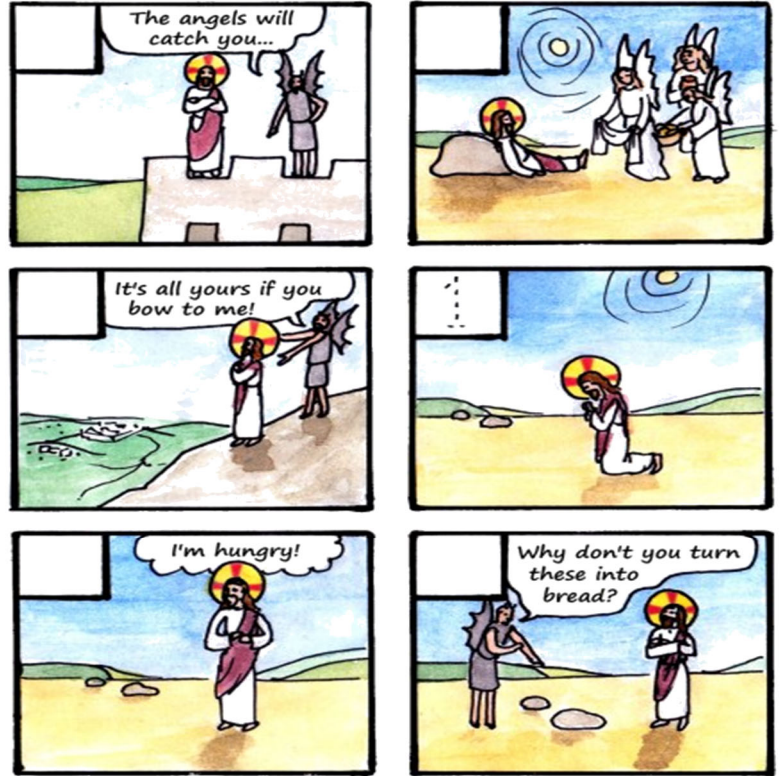

## What Happens in Lent?

In today's Gospel story, Jesus goes out into the desert to fast and pray for forty days. In the forty days of Lent, the Church asks us to fast, give alms, and pray.



In Lent we don't eat meat on Fridays. Many people give up things like candy or dessert for all of Lent. When we give up food that we like, it reminds us that food isn't the only thing we need- we need God too!



Giving alms means giving money or things to the poor or the Church. God lets there be people who need our help so that we can become better by helping them!

The third thing that we should do in Lent is praying. You could say an extra prayer every day- maybe an "Our Father" or a "Hail Mary" when you wake up or before you go to bed. Another good idea is reading a bit from the Bible, because when we read the Bible we let God speak to us.

What are some little things you could do for Lent? Try to do things that will help you think a bit more about God every day.

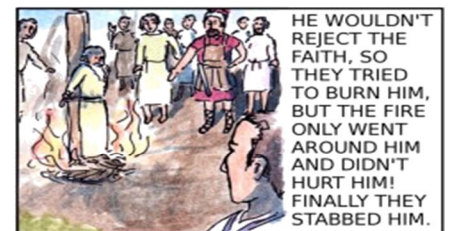
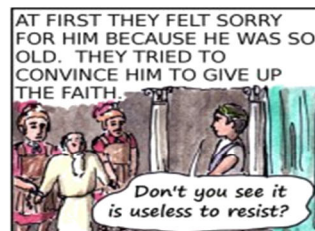
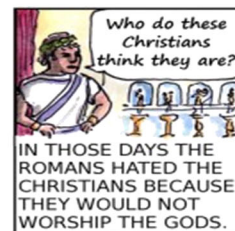
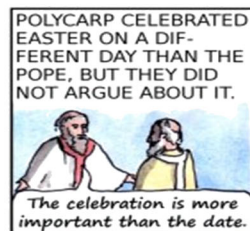
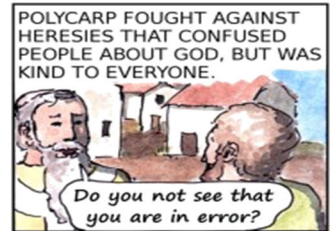
