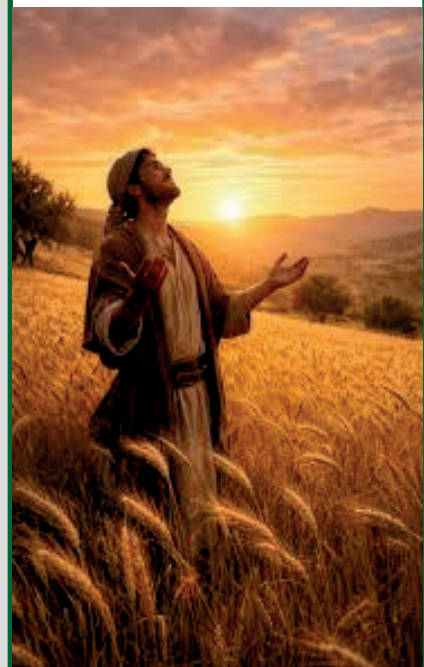

MESSAGE FROM FR. BENNY **Sharing Jesus' Mission**

Today's Gospel is, in effect, a reminder from God to each one of us: "You have received grace and talents from Me without charge, and so you have to give without charge through your simple, responsible, sharing lives." This is indeed the core of the priestly vocation and of the vocation of every Christian through his or her Baptism.

Be healers in the modern world: People are sick in body as well as mind. As Christians sharing Jesus' mission, we can bring healing and wholeness to people with whom we come into contact. Although we cannot raise the dead, we can help people to recover interest and a zest for living. People can be physically alive but dead in many other respects. "Cleansing the lepers" means rehabilitating and bringing back fully into our communities all those who, for one reason or another, are marginalized, rejected, despised, or ostracized on the basis of race, nationality, marital status, financial condition, religion, gender or sexual orientation. We have to help casting out from our people the demons who possess them by means of addictions to alcohol, nicotine, drugs, pornography, sexual deviations, and the like, first by asking God and others for help to free ourselves from our own chains of evil addictions, and then turning to helping others to remove theirs in the same way.

We are invited to become one with God and Jesus, and to let the Holy Spirit work through us. We are asked to perform the works of Jesus, and through these works to reveal the power and character of God to the world. If we accept this invitation and live it out wholeheartedly, with God's grace people will look at us and say, "Jesus!"

UN MENSAJE DEL PADRE BENNY **Compartir la misión de Jesús**

El Evangelio de hoy es, en efecto, un recordatorio de Dios para cada uno de nosotros: «Has recibido de Mí gracia y talentos gratuitamente; por tanto, debes dar gratuitamente a través de una vida sencilla, responsable y solidaria». Este es, ciertamente, el núcleo de la vocación sacerdotal y de la vocación de todo cristiano en virtud de su Bautismo.

Sed sanadores en el mundo actual: las personas están enfermas tanto en el cuerpo como en la mente. Como cristianos que compartimos la misión de Jesús, podemos llevar sanación y plenitud a las personas con las que nos relacionamos. Aunque no podemos resucitar a los muertos, sí podemos ayudar a las personas a recuperar el interés y el entusiasmo por vivir. Hay personas que están vivas físicamente, pero muertas en muchos otros aspectos. «Limpiar a los leprosos» significa rehabilitar e integrar plenamente en nuestras comunidades a todos aquellos que, por una razón u otra, son marginados, rechazados, despreciados o excluidos debido a su raza, nacionalidad, estado civil, situación económica, religión, género u orientación sexual. Debemos ayudar a expulsar de entre nosotros los demonios que poseen a las personas mediante adicciones al alcohol, la nicotina, las drogas, la pornografía, las desviaciones sexuales y similares; primero, pidiendo ayuda a Dios y a los demás para liberarnos de nuestras propias cadenas de adicciones nocivas y, después, ayudando a otros a librarse de las suyas del mismo modo.

Se nos invita a ser uno con Dios y con Jesús, y a permitir que el Espíritu Santo actúe a través de nosotros. Se nos pide realizar las obras de Jesús y, mediante ellas, revelar al mundo el poder y el carácter de Dios. Si aceptamos esta invitación y la vivimos de todo corazón, con la gracia de Dios, la gente nos mirará y dirá: «¡Jesús!».
