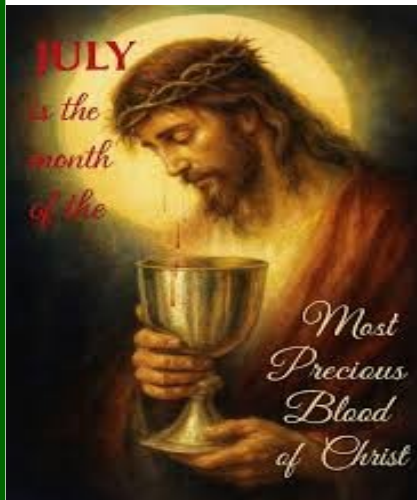

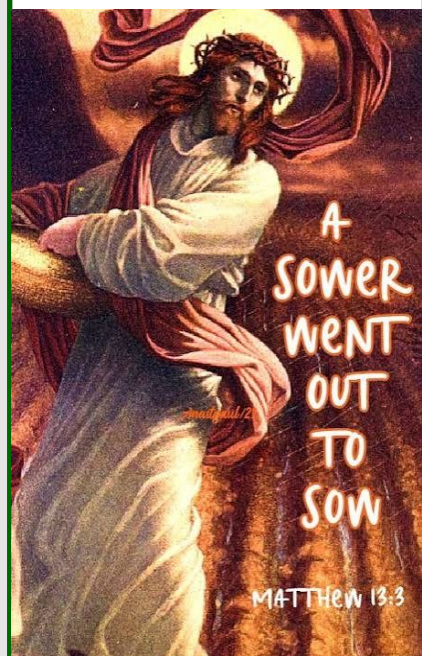

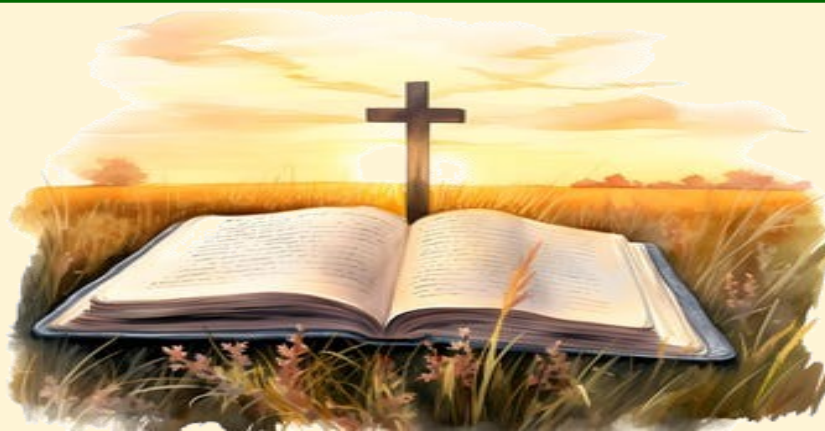

MESSAGE FROM FR. BENNY

Preparations required to receive the Word of God!

We need to assess our use of the word of God. We need to **read the word of God every day**, starting with a prayer to the Holy Spirit for the gifts of attentive reading and the ability and willingness to **apply the message** we receive to our daily living. When we listen to the word of God as read and preached in the Church during the Holy Mass, or in a televised program, we need to **pay full attention to the message** given by God, Who uses the priest or preacher as His instrument.

We need to keep our spiritual soil free from weeds, fertile, and well-prepared for the word of God: **First**, we need to keep our **hearts open** to the word of God instead of closing it with pride, prejudice, fear, or laziness. **Second**, we also need to ask God's special grace to **remove all types of blocks which harden** our hearts, like laziness, anxiety, worries, hatred, jealousy, prejudice and the burden of un-repentant/unconfessed sins, any of which can prevent the word of God from influencing and transforming our lives. **Third**, we have to remove from our hearts **the weeds** like evil habits and addictions, evil tendencies, hatred, jealousy, fear, and greed. **Fourth**, we should not allow the trials and tribulations of this world: the cares of this world, our ambitions, or our desires for worldly success and happiness, to **choke out** the messages that God gives through His word. **Last**, we have to keep the **soil of our hearts fertile** by our prayer life, repenting daily of our sins receiving the sacrament of reconciliation when necessary, and receiving the spiritual food of the Holy Eucharist by participating in the Holy Mass. When we receive Jesus, the Word of God and the Source of the word of God [Holy Scripture and Sacred Tradition], in Holy Communion we need to ask him to transform our lives so that we may see Jesus in all of us and share with each Jesus' unconditional love, mercy, compassion, and forgiveness.

UN MENSAJE DEL PADRE BENNY

¡Preparativos necesarios para recibir la Palabra de Dios!

Debemos evaluar cómo nos relacionamos con **la Palabra de Dios**. **Es preciso leerla a diario**, comenzando con una oración al Espíritu Santo para pedir los dones de una lectura atenta, así como la capacidad y la disposición de **aplicar el mensaje** recibido a nuestra vida cotidiana. Al escuchar la Palabra de Dios —ya sea leída y predicada en la Iglesia durante la Santa Misa o a través de un programa de televisión—, debemos **prestar plena atención al mensaje** que nos transmite Dios, quien se vale del sacerdote o del predicador como instrumento suyo. Hemos de mantener la tierra de nuestro espíritu libre de maleza, fértil y bien preparada para recibir la Palabra de Dios: en primer lugar, debemos mantener el **corazón abierto** a ella, en lugar de cerrarlo por orgullo, prejuicios, miedo o pereza. En segundo lugar, necesitamos pedir a Dios la gracia especial para **eliminar cualquier obstáculo que endurezca** nuestro corazón —como la pereza, la ansiedad, las preocupaciones, el odio, los celos, los prejuicios o la carga de pecados no arrepentidos ni confesados—, pues cualquiera de estas cosas puede impedir que la Palabra de Dios influya en nuestras vidas y las transforme. En **tercer** lugar, debemos arrancar de nuestro corazón **la maleza**, como los malos hábitos y las adicciones, las inclinaciones perversas, el odio, los celos, el miedo y la codicia. En **cuarto** lugar, no debemos permitir que las pruebas y tribulaciones de este mundo —las preocupaciones terrenales, nuestras ambiciones o el deseo de éxito y felicidad mundanos— ahoguen los mensajes que Dios nos transmite a través de su Palabra. Por **último**, debemos mantener **fértil la tierra de nuestro corazón** mediante la vida de oración, arrepintiéndonos diariamente de nuestros pecados, recibiendo el sacramento de la reconciliación cuando sea necesario y alimentándonos espiritualmente con la Sagrada Eucaristía al participar en la Santa Misa. Al recibir a Jesús —la Palabra de Dios y la Fuente de la misma (las Sagradas Escrituras y la Sagrada Tradición)— en la Sagrada Comunión, debemos pedirle que transforme nuestras vidas para que sepamos ver a Jesús en los demás y compartir con cada persona su amor incondicional, su misericordia, su compasión y su perdón.

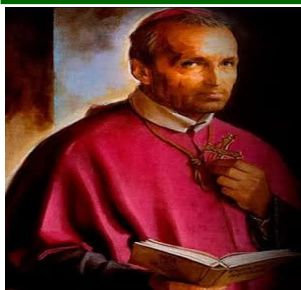

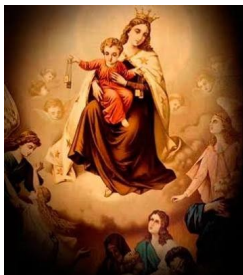

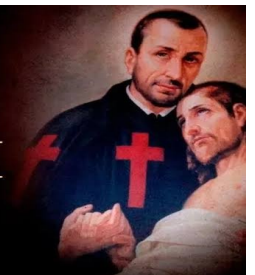

Order of Christian Initiation For Adults

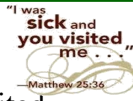

Here is the parable Our Lord told in today's Gospel reading, with pictures!

A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some of the  fell on on the , and  came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had little soil.

It sprang up at once because the soil was not deep, and when the  rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of . Some  fell among , and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some  fell on rich soil and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty, or thirty-fold.

God's Word is Like Seed...

 In today's Gospel reading, Jesus explains the parable of the sower and the seed to the disciples. Like the seed, the word of God comes to all sorts of people. Some people hear it and the devil takes it away, like the seed that falls on the path and is eaten by the birds. Some people hear God's word and love it for a little while, but they don't let it grow deeply in themselves, like the seed on rocky ground that doesn't grow good roots. Some people hear God's word and it starts to grow in them, but they have so many other things going on in their lives that they forget God. 

The people who hear the word of God and let it grow in them are like the good soil. When the sower plants the seed in the good soil it gets deep roots, grows high and produces a good harvest. When we receive the word of God well, it takes root in us so that it is really deep in our hearts. It grows when we feed it by learning more about God and trying to love Him more. It produces a harvest when other people come to love God because of us. 

What kind of soil are you like? Do you let God's word be snatched away as soon as you hear it? Do you let it take root in your heart and love it, or is it like the seed sown on rocky ground that is too shallow? Do you let other things in your life crowd out God's life in you, or do you let God's word in deep and feed it and let it grow?
