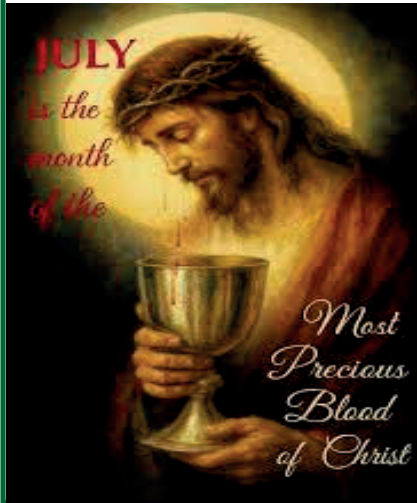

The Parable of the Weeds and the Wheat

MESSAGE FROM FR. SINTO

Stay Awake in the Lord

A farmer carefully sowed good seeds in his field, but ‘while everyone was asleep,’ the enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat (Matthew 13:24-43). This simple detail carries a powerful spiritual lesson. The enemy did not strike while the workers were alert and watchful, but during a moment of carelessness.

The same danger exists in our spiritual lives. We prepare the soil of our hearts through prayer, the sacraments, and the Word of God. We sow good seeds by practicing charity, forgiveness, and faithfulness. After making spiritual progress, we may become complacent. Pride, overconfidence, or indifference can lull us into a spiritual sleep. We begin to think that our journey is complete and that there is no longer any need for vigilance. It is precisely then that the enemy seeks to sow the weeds of temptation, resentment, selfishness, and sin.

Jesus reminds us that the Christian life requires constant vigilance. Our relationship with God is not a one-time achievement but a daily commitment. Every day we are invited to nourish the good seed through prayer, Holy Mass, Scripture, and acts of love.

Let us reject every form of spiritual lethargy and faithfully guard the treasure of our faith. With Christ watching over us, the good seed He has planted will bear an abundant harvest for the Kingdom of God.

Mantente despierto en el Señor

Un agricultor sembró cuidadosamente buena semilla en su campo, pero «mientras todos dormían», el enemigo vino y sembró cizaña entre el trigo (Mateo 13:24-43). Este sencillo detalle encierra una poderosa lección espiritual. El enemigo no atacó cuando los trabajadores estaban alertas y vigilantes, sino durante un momento de descuido.

El mismo peligro existe en nuestra vida espiritual. Preparamos la tierra de nuestros corazones mediante la oración, los sacramentos y la Palabra de Dios. Sembramos buena semilla practicando la caridad, el perdón y la fidelidad. Tras lograr avances espirituales, podemos caer en la autocomplacencia. El orgullo, el exceso de confianza o la indiferencia pueden sumirnos en un sueño espiritual. Empezamos a pensar que nuestro camino ha concluido y que ya no es necesaria la vigilancia. Es precisamente entonces cuando el enemigo busca sembrar la cizaña de la tentación, el resentimiento, el egoísmo y el pecado.

Jesús nos recuerda que la vida cristiana exige una vigilancia constante. Nuestra relación con Dios no es un logro puntual, sino un compromiso diario. Cada día se nos invita a nutrir la buena semilla mediante la oración, la Santa Misa, las Escrituras y los actos de amor.

Rechacemos toda forma de letargo espiritual y custodiemos fielmente el tesoro de nuestra fe. Con Cristo velando por nosotros, la buena semilla que Él ha plantado dará una cosecha abundante para el Reino de Dios.

Order of Christian Initiation For Adults

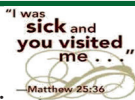

The Salesian Sisters were founded by St. John Bosco in 1872 and started their work in mission lands in 1877. Their congregation was specifically founded for the service of poor youth. They are a worldwide community spreading the Gospel in areas affected by great poverty, disease, war and other conditions such as areas of natural disaster and refugee camps. They provide missionaries for Africa, Asia Latin America and Pacific Islands dedicating themselves to children, young people, families the wounded and the dying.

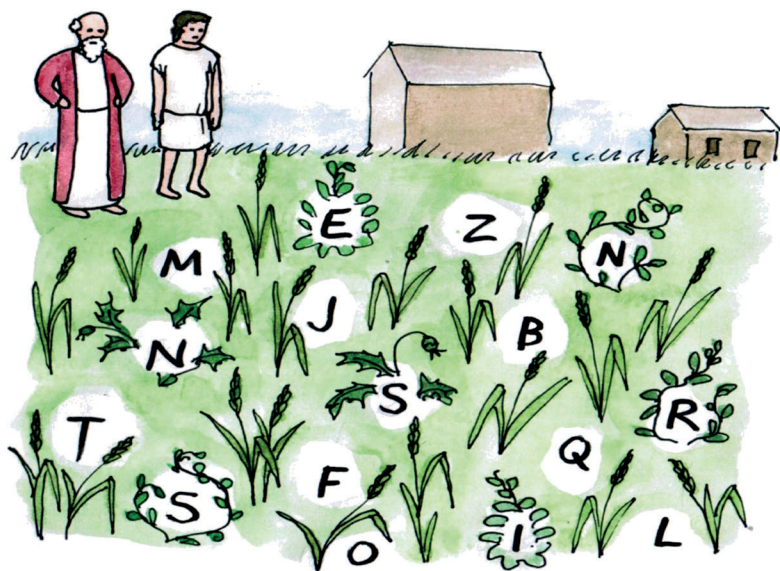

Las Hijas de María Auxiliadora (Salesianas) fueron fundadas por San Juan Bosco en 1872 e iniciaron su labor en tierras de misión en 1877. Su congregación nació específicamente para servir a la juventud pobre. Son una comunidad de alcance mundial que difunde el Evangelio en zonas afectadas por la pobreza extrema, las enfermedades, la guerra y otras situaciones críticas, como áreas azotadas por desastres naturales y campos de refugiados. Envían misioneras a África, Asia, América Latina y las islas del Pacífico, dedicándose a atender a niños, jóvenes, familias, heridos y moribundos.

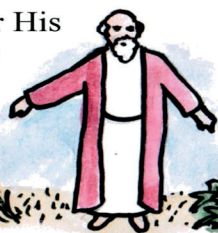
Weeds Among the Wheat



Weeds are plants that shouldn't be there. They use the sun and water that the good plants need. Have you ever helped pick weeds in the garden? In today's parable Jesus tells about a man who lets the weeds grow along with the wheat until harvest time, so that the good plants don't get pulled up along with the weeds.

The weeds represent the bad people, who will go to Hell at the final judgement. God lets them stay alive as long as the good people. He wants to give sinners lots of time to repent so that they can go to Heaven instead.

All the readings today are about God's mercy. God is the most powerful of all, but instead of destroying sinners He wants to give them more chances. When you think about it, you will realize God has already been merciful to all of us- because we have all sinned. We should thank God for His mercy, and if we do sin again we should show Him we are sorry by going to Confession.

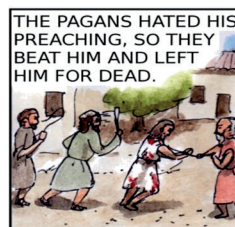
St. Appollinaris of Ravenna July 20

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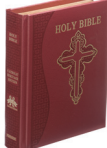


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
