## Message from Fr. Davy's Desk:

This weekend we are celebrating the feast of the Precious Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi. The most precious gift that Jesus Christ gave to the Church is the gift of his own body and blood. All around the world the Church is celebrating this feast solemnly with Eucharistic Procession, Benediction, Holy Hour, Forty Hours, etc. Holy Eucharist is the center of our faith and the source of our energy.

Saint Paul, though was not present during the last supper, received the real spirit of the Holy Eucharist and explains very clearly in his first letter to the Corinthians: "The Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way he took the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." (1 Corinthians 11:23-25)

Jesus invites us to the banquet. "Do this in remembrance of me ...." This is the last thing Jesus asked us to do before he died. He asked to keep doing it as often as possible until his return in glory. We believe in the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. There are many miraculous healing and favors received to people who prayed in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. It is a great proof of the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Can there be a religion in which God is closer to man than our Catholic Christianity? We feel his loving presence in the Eucharist.

If we are struggling with sins let us ask Jesus to strengthen us through this sacrament. Let us today ask our Lord Jesus to increase our faith in the Holy Eucharist. Let the Body and Blood of Jesus nourish us every day.

Wish you all a grace-filled feast of the Body and Blood of Christ.

(1 Corintios 11: 23-25)

Jesús nos invita al banquete. "Haz esto en recuerdo de mí ...". Esto es lo último que Jesús nos pidió que hiciéramos antes de morir. Pidió seguir haciéndolo con la mayor frecuencia posible hasta su regreso en gloria. Creemos en la presencia real de Jesús en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Hay muchas curas milagrosas y favores recibidos por personas que rezaron en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento. Es una gran prueba de la presencia real de Jesús en la Sagrada Eucaristía. ¿Puede haber una religión en la que Dios está más cerca del hombre que nuestro cristianismo católico? Sentimos su amorosa presencia en la Eucaristía.

Si estamos luchando con los pecados, pidamos a Jesús que nos fortalezca a través de este sacramento. Pidamos hoy a nuestro Señor Jesús que aumente nuestra fe en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Dejen que el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús nos nutran todos los días.
