From Fr. Davy's Desk:

My dear friends, this Fathers' Day we celebrate the Feast of Saint Anthony and Confirmation of seventeen young adults of our Parish. Saint Anthony continues interceding for our parish.

Through this Sunday Gospel reading Jesus explains to us the mystery of seeds. Two parables in today's Gospel are on the Kingdom of God similar to the seeds. The farmer scatters the seeds. The seed is capable of sprouting and growing. In the second parable he says that the Kingdom of God is like a tiny mustard seed which grows to become the greatest of all shrubs.

Faith starts from the smallest beginnings in our hearts when we receive God's word. Just as a seed has no power to change itself until it is planted in the ground, so we cannot change our lives without God's help. God gives us the power of his Holy Spirit. God transforms us by the power of his Spirit. When we learn about the life of Saint Anthony we know that he allowed the seed of faith planted in him to grow bigger. He nourished it with the sacraments and shared the fruits with others. Let the young adults who receive the sacrament of confirmation be able to nourish their faith and grow in holiness.

Are we ready to let God change us by his grace and power? When we yield to Jesus, our lives are transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit who dwells in us. Jesus sowed his seed in our hearts when we were baptized. Are we ready to let the seed grow in our hearts? What can we do this week to plant a seed in our hearts? How can we help the seed grow bigger and produce fruits for others? What in our lives has to change to make that happen?

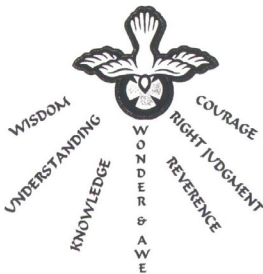

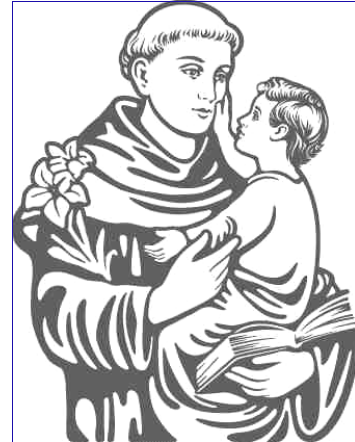
