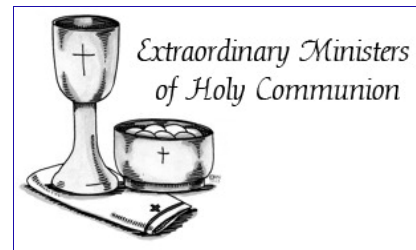
Christmas Raffle
