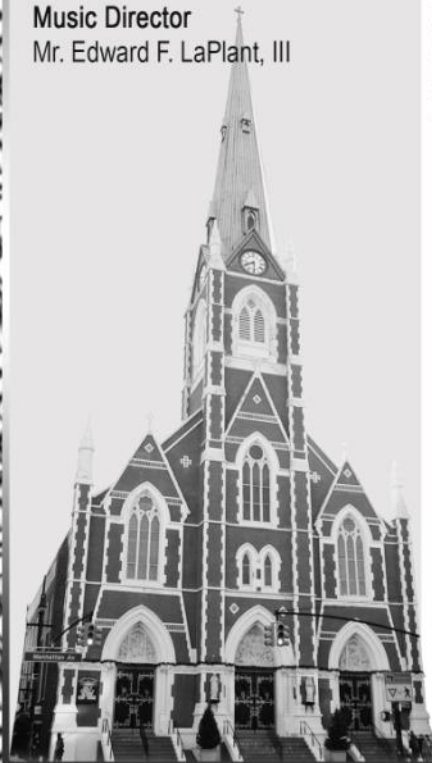

This weekend as we continue celebrating the Easter joy, the Gospel passage reminds us about the miraculous catch of fish. Peter and companions, the disciples of Jesus, were expert fishermen. They caught nothing after spending hours fishing. When they did as the risen Lord commanded, they got plenty. The ocean experience of the disciples teaches us a great lesson. We work hard daily. Sometimes when we do projects by our own, we may not succeed. But when we listen to God and do accordingly, we will be amazed to see the miraculous result.

This Sunday, nineteen children are receiving the First Holy Communion in our parish during the 12:30 p.m. Mass. It is a great opportunity for them to realize and experience the power of Jesus in them. The risen Lord shared breakfast with the disciples. This refers not only to the physical food but also spiritual food. Jesus continues nourishing us daily, by offering his body and blood through the Holy Eucharist. The joy of the disciples after the miraculous catch and the breakfast with Jesus was awesome. In the same way, the joy of every Christian when receiving the Holy Eucharist is indescribable.

The children who are receiving the Holy Eucharist today are well trained and prepared by their teachers and parents. They made their confession and prepared their hearts to receive Jesus.
